It is very easy to enter your recipe(s) directly into our cookbook.

Here is how you do it:

- 1). Go to www.fundcraft.com
- 2). Look for the green writing on the right side of screen and scroll down to the blank Box marked “Web ID”, (members).
- 3). Click on this blank box marked “WEB ID” and enter: 36834-07QV. Then, click “log in”.
- 4). Read through all of the instructions on this page. Then, when you are ready, click on the Pink, “*post recipes*”.
- 5). Now, enter your recipe!
- 6). If you plan on entering more than one recipe, please use the same format each time and enter each recipe separately. Also, enter your name the exact same way on each.
- 7). Please kindly check your recipe for any typos, and recipe errors, etc. You can spell check your recipe by clicking on the bar, “spell check”. Double check, you are responsible for your own editing.
- 8). When you have finished entering your recipe and notations and you are ready to submit, click on the box marked “submit”. You are done!
